





Help your child in these skills first


- Relating to others
 - build social skills and interact with people around him/her [e.g. ask for permission, say hello and smile, control their emotions]
- Developing good personal habits
- Nurturing positive learning attitudes





Examples of Personal Habits, Routines

Routines help your child build confidence and learn to manage things by themselves.









Support a healthy lifestyle

Help your child with

- Sufficient sleep (9 -10h)
- A balanced diet
- Unstructured, self-directed play
- Outdoor physical activities





Affirm your child

Recognise small successes

Focus on the efforts, not

the results



Spend time to talk to them



- Understand what your child needs most
- Discuss worries together
- Share fond memories of your own primary school days [©]
- Ask them to share their thoughts and feelings.
- Ask <u>other questions</u> besides the academic learning e.g. I had a great day at work. How about you? Have you helped anyone today?



Useful things to reduce anxiety

- Label all their belongings (name & class)
- Memorise one parent's number

- Give them simple pencil cases, stationery and bags
- Learn to use the toilet, toilet paper
- Learn to dress themselves, button up, tuck in their shirts (especially after using the washrooms)




 Please avoid giving your child drinks such as yoghurt and fresh milk which may spoil easily.

- Students are allowed to wear their P.E. attire on days when they have PE or PAL.








Child's ID Tag

- We will bring you through using one example.






